



INTRODUCTION

The Derwent Valley Line branches off to the east from the Midland Main Line around ten miles north of Derby. It runs between Ambergate and Matlock – a distance of around eight miles.

This Train Simulator route includes five stations and numerous new custom assets. Also included are 20 scenarios. Seven of these scenarios are available in two versions: one version which uses default Train Simulator stock (these scenarios are prefixed with [DEFAULT]) and one version which requires additional payware stock. The other six scenarios are only operable using additional payware stock.

IMPORTANT! This route is an add-on for the Just Trains Midland Main Line: Sheffield-Derby route which must be installed to allow the Derwent Valley Line to operate.



Train Simulator requirements

If you purchased Train Simulator after 20 September 2012 you will require the European Loco & Asset Pack (available to purchase via <u>Steam</u>) for this route to display correctly and for some scenarios to work.

Some of the scenarios supplied with this Midland Main Line: Derwent Valley Line route require rolling stock that is not supplied with this software. Full details of the rolling stock required for each scenario are provided in the <u>SCENARIOS</u> section of this manual.

Scenery quality and display settings

Various effects and techniques have been used in the modelling of this Derwent Valley Line software to enhance the realism of the route, including TSX technology for realistic night lighting effects.


Due to the high level of detail provided along the route, it is best to run the route at the highest settings your PC can manage. Settings can all be accessed via the Settings > Graphics menu in Train Simulator. The route will still run at lower settings, of course, but some of the assets may not be displayed as intended.



Run in 64-bit mode!

We strongly advise you to run Train Simulator in 64-bit mode to enhance its stability:

- 1. Run the Steam client and select 'Games' from the top menu.
- 2. Select 'Train Simulator' from the left-side menu and press the blue 'PLAY' button in the top centre of the window. The option to 'Play Train Simulator' or 'Play Train Simulator 64-bit Edition' will pop up.
- 3. Select the 64-bit option and press 'PLAY'.



INSTALLATION, UPDATES AND SUPPORT

You can install this Derwent Valley Line software as often as you like on the same computer system. To re-download the software:

- 1. Click on the 'Account' tab on the Just Trains website.
- 2. Log in to your account.
- 3. Click on the 'Your Orders' button.
- 4. A list of your purchases will appear and you can then re-download the software you require.

Uninstalling

To uninstall this product from your system, select the appropriate option for your version of Windows from the Control Panel:

- 'Programs and Features' (Windows 7/8)
- 'Apps & features' (Windows 10 or later)

Select the product you want to uninstall and then select the 'Uninstall' option, following the on-screen instructions to uninstall the product.






POINTS OF INTEREST ON THE ROUTE

Many buildings and other features of interest have been modelled along the length of the route – these are some of them, listed in the order you'd see them when driving from Ambergate to Matlock:

Ambergate Junction






This is where the branch line to Matlock diverges from the main line.

Ambergate bridges



These two bridges are built next to each other and both carry track over two roads and a river.

Ambergate station old platform



A now disused platform that used to be part of the station can be seen north of the road bridge past the current station.

Cromford Canal




Completed in 1794, the Cromford Canal runs for around 14 miles between Cromford and the Erewash Canal in Derbyshire. A six-mile section between Cromford and Ambergate is listed as a Site of Special Biological Interest.



Whatstandwell bridge


This bridge takes the line over the River Derwent.

Caravan park



A caravan park can be seen on both sides of the line where it crosses the River Derwent.

Cromford aqueduct



This carries the Cromford Canal over the railway.

Lea Wood Tunnel



This carries the line through the hill at this location.

Cromford girder bridge



The Cromford girder bridge carries the line over the River Derwent at the north end of the Lea Wood Tunnel.

Water treatment works



The Cromford water treatment works are located on the right side of the track.

High Peak Junction



High Peak Junction is the name currently used to describe the area where the former Cromford and High Peak Railway, whose workshops were situated here, meets the Cromford Canal.

Cromford viaduct



This is located just before Cromford station and carries the line over the River Derwent.

Willersley Tunnel




This tunnel is 794 yards in length and was built around 1849.

Heights of Abraham



The Heights of Abraham is a 60-acre country park that provides spectacular views over the surrounding countryside. Its unique feature is its cable car service.

High Tor tunnels



This series of tunnels allows the route to pass through the hillside to gain access to Matlock.

Matlock Derwent viaduct



This viaduct just before Matlock station carries the line over the River Derwent.

Matlock supermarket



This modern supermarket is situated close to Matlock station.

SCENARIOS

20 scenarios for the Derwent Valley Line are included. Seven of these are available in two versions: one version which uses default Train Simulator stock (these scenarios are prefixed with [DEFAULT]) and one version which requires additional payware stock. The other six scenarios are only operable using additional payware stock.

If you purchased Train Simulator after 20 September 2012, you will require the European Loco & Asset Pack (available to purchase via <u>Steam</u>) for all the scenarios to operate correctly.

Choosing a scenario

When you first start Train Simulator, select the 'Drive' option in the Main Menu, then choose either the 'Standard' or the 'Free Roam' scenarios.

Use the scroll bar on the right side to scroll down to 'Just Trains – Midland Main Line'. The scenarios specific to the Derwent Valley Line have the prefix [DV] in their title.

You can now choose your scenario and click on the 'Go' button.
