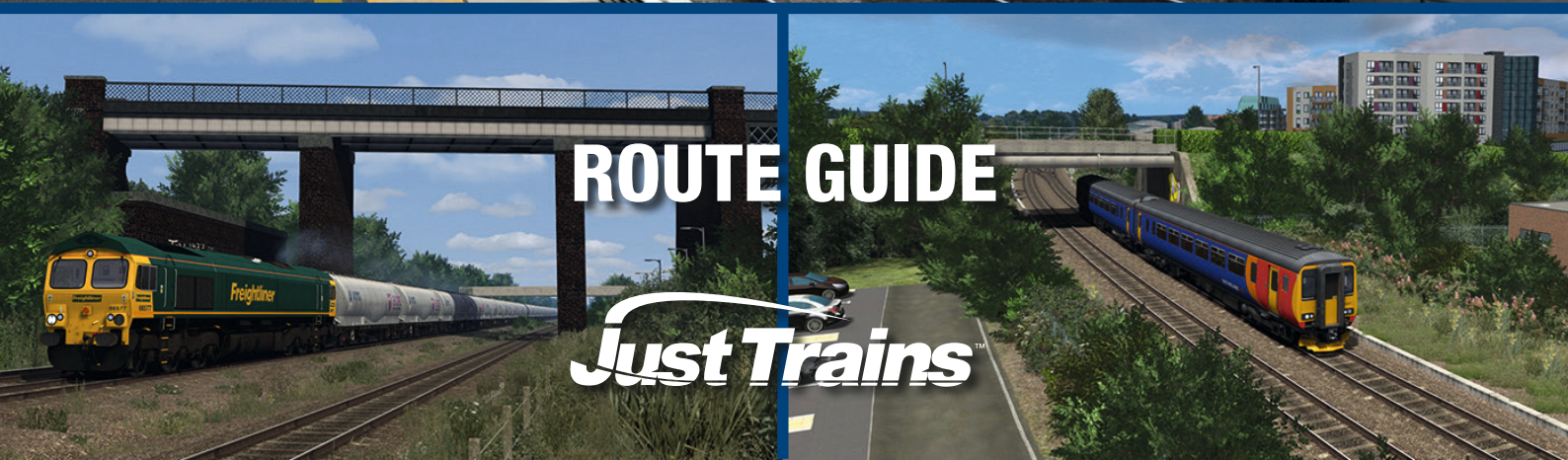

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# INTRODUCTION

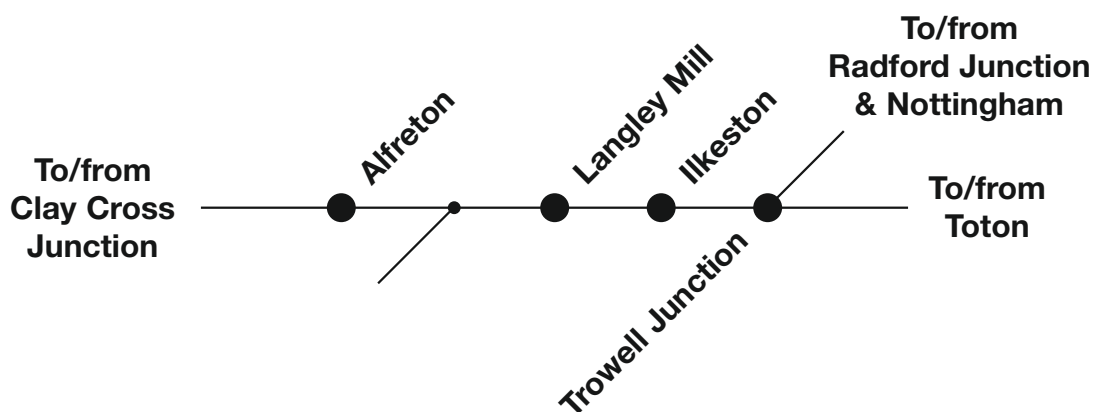
This route is an extension for Just Trains' Midland Main Line: Derby-Nottingham-Leicester Extension route, which must be installed in Train Simulator for this route to display and operate correctly.

The line branches off the Midland Main Line at Clay Cross Junction, heading south. It is approximately 23 miles in length and includes the section from Trowell Junction to Mansfield Junction via Radford Junction. This section is used by passenger services to and from Nottingham. Also included is the freight line to Toton via Sandiacre.

The route includes the stations at Alferton, Langley Mill and Ilkeston. As well as being used for passenger services, the route carries large amounts of freight to the yards at Toton and is the second busiest freight line in the East Midlands.

The Erewash Valley route is Quick Drive enabled and includes numerous new custom assets.

16 Standard scenarios are included that require additional payware add-ons to run and 12 Standard scenarios are provided which only require the European Loco and Asset Pack and the default stock included with Train Simulator. See the [SCENARIOS](#) section for all the details.





## Train Simulator requirements

If you purchased Train Simulator after 20 September 2012 you will require the European Loco & Asset Pack (available to purchase via [Steam](#)) for this route to display correctly and for some scenarios to work.

Some of the scenarios supplied with this Erewash Valley route require rolling stock that is not supplied with this software. Full details of the rolling stock required for each scenario are provided in the [SCENARIOS](#) section of this manual.

## Scenery quality and display settings

Various effects and techniques have been used in the modelling of Erewash Valley to enhance the realism of the route, including TSX technology for realistic night lighting effects.

We recommend running the route with 'Procedural Flora' turned off via Settings > Graphics > Advanced > Next and then Save.

Due to the high level of detail which has been modelled, it is best to run the route at the highest settings your PC can manage. Settings can all be accessed via the Settings > Graphics menu in Train Simulator. The route will still run at lower settings, of course, but some of the assets may not be displayed as intended.

## Run in 64-bit mode!

We strongly advise you to run Train Simulator in 64-bit mode to enhance its stability:

1. Run the Steam client and select 'Games' from the top menu.
2. Select 'Train Simulator' from the left-side menu and press the blue 'PLAY' button in the top centre of the window. The option to 'Play Train Simulator' or 'Play Train Simulator 64-bit Edition' will pop up.
3. Select the 64-bit option and press 'Play'.





# INSTALLATION, UPDATES AND SUPPORT

You can install this add-on as often as you like on the same computer system. To re-download the Midland Main Line: Erewash Valley software:

1. Click on the 'Account' tab on the [Just Trains](#) website.
2. Log in to your account.

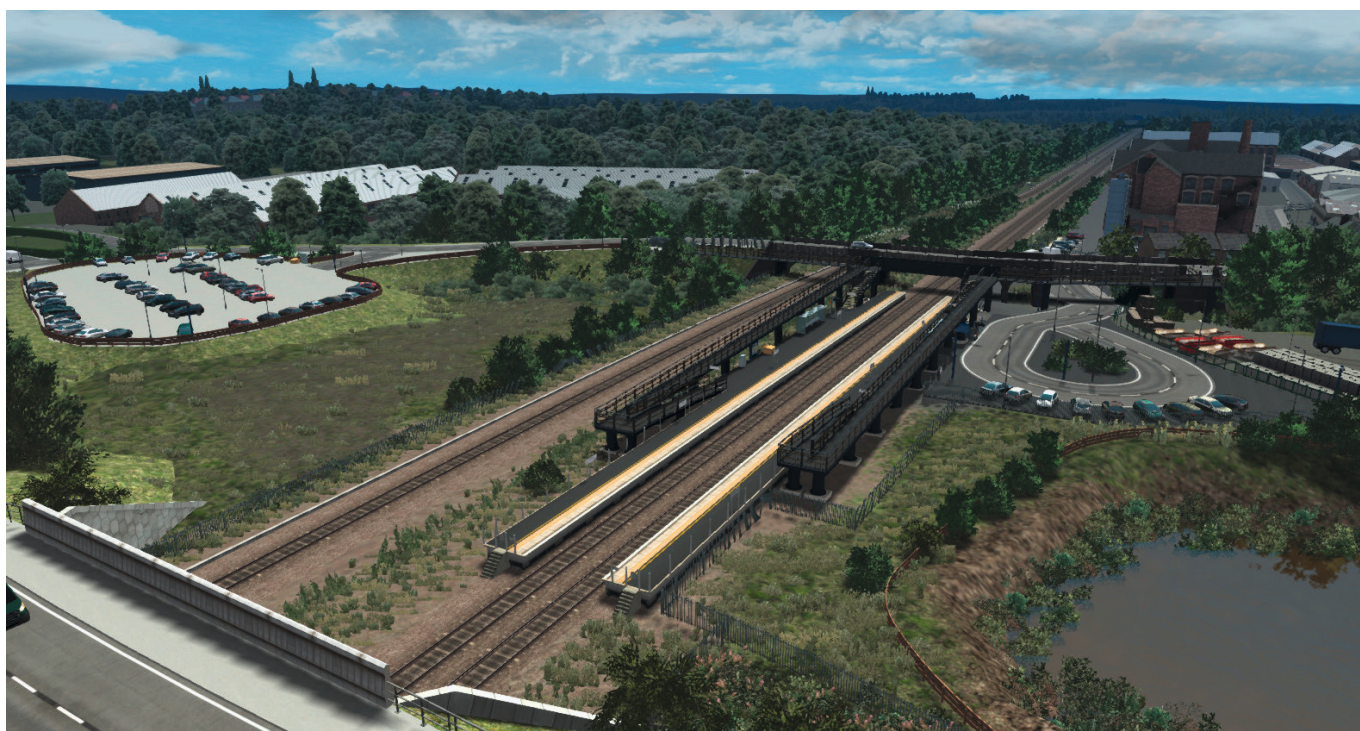

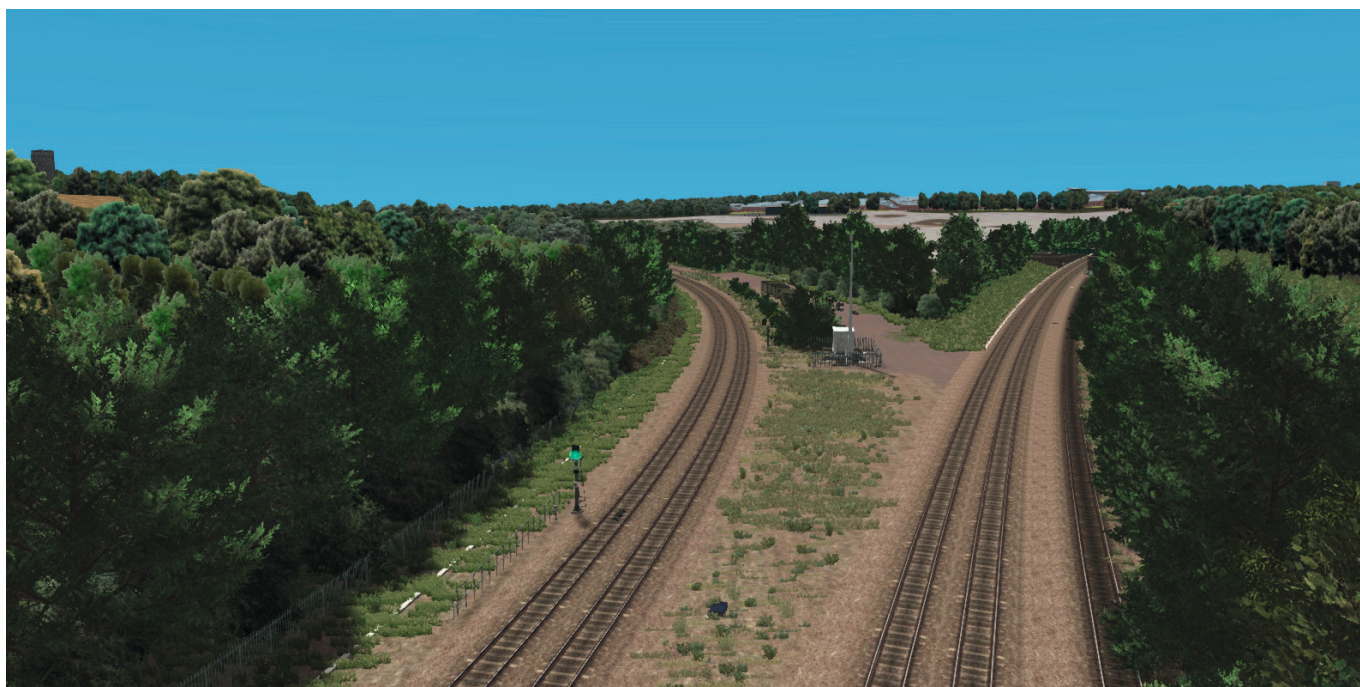

# FEATURES TO LOOK OUT FOR ON THE ROUTE

Landmark buildings and other features of interest have been modelled along the length of the route – these are some of them, listed in the order you'd see them when driving south from the start of the Erewash Valley route:

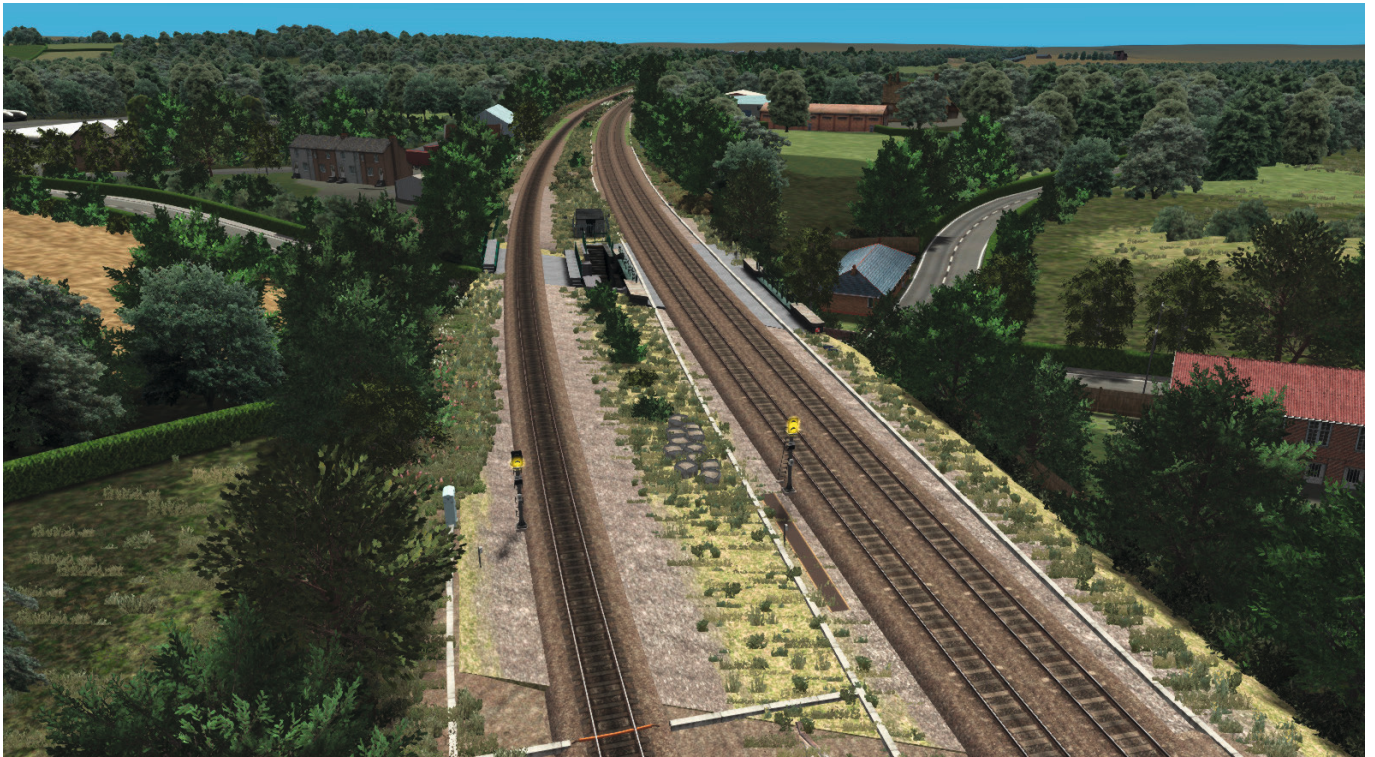
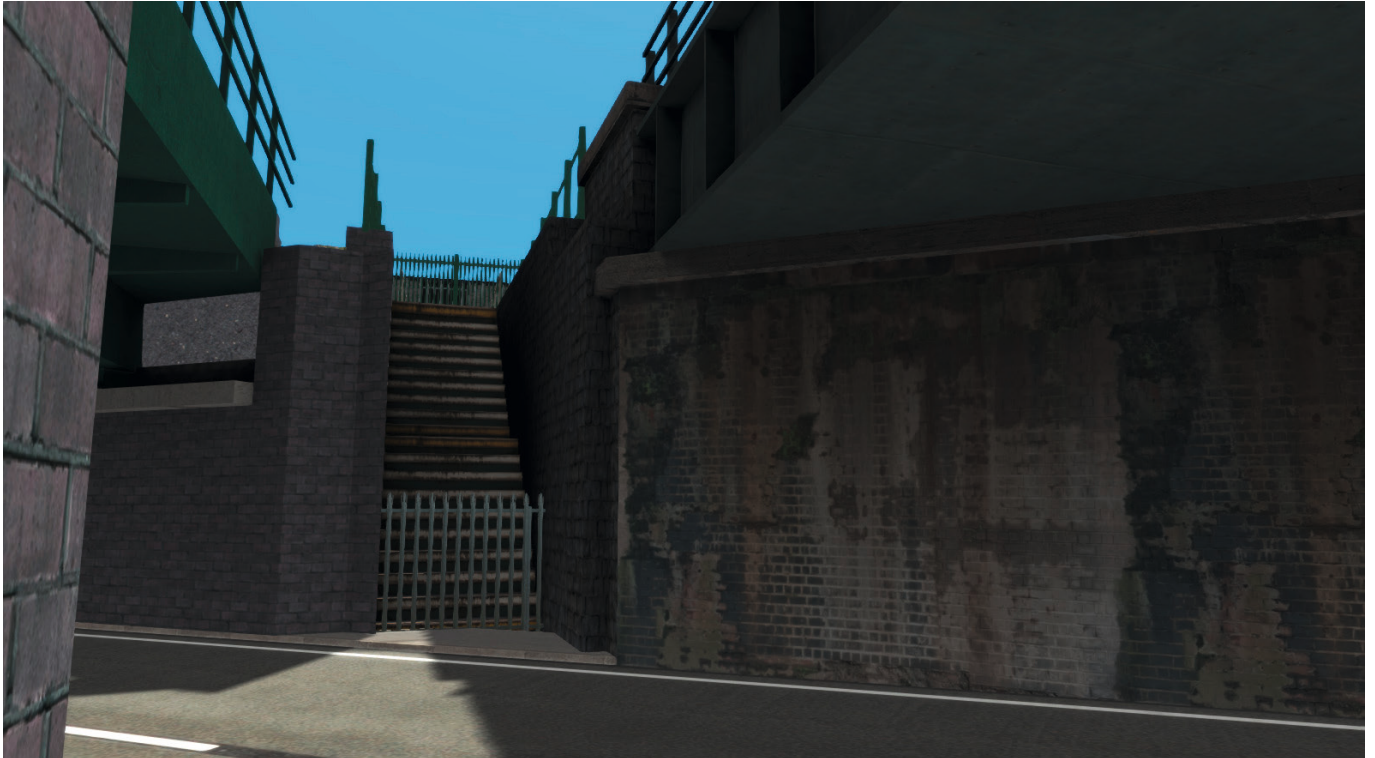
## Clay Cross Junction



This junction is where the Erewash Valley line branches off from the main Midland Main Line route towards the South-East.



## Doe Hill bridge and site of closed station



Doe Hill station was closed on 12 September 1960 and was situated on the bridge. The passenger entrance to the station from the footpath on the road below the bridge was via a set of stairs between the lines above.



## Site of Westhouses & Blackwell station



This station closed on 2 January 1967.

## Site of Blackwell Junctions



This set of junctions used to serve the now disused collieries in the area.

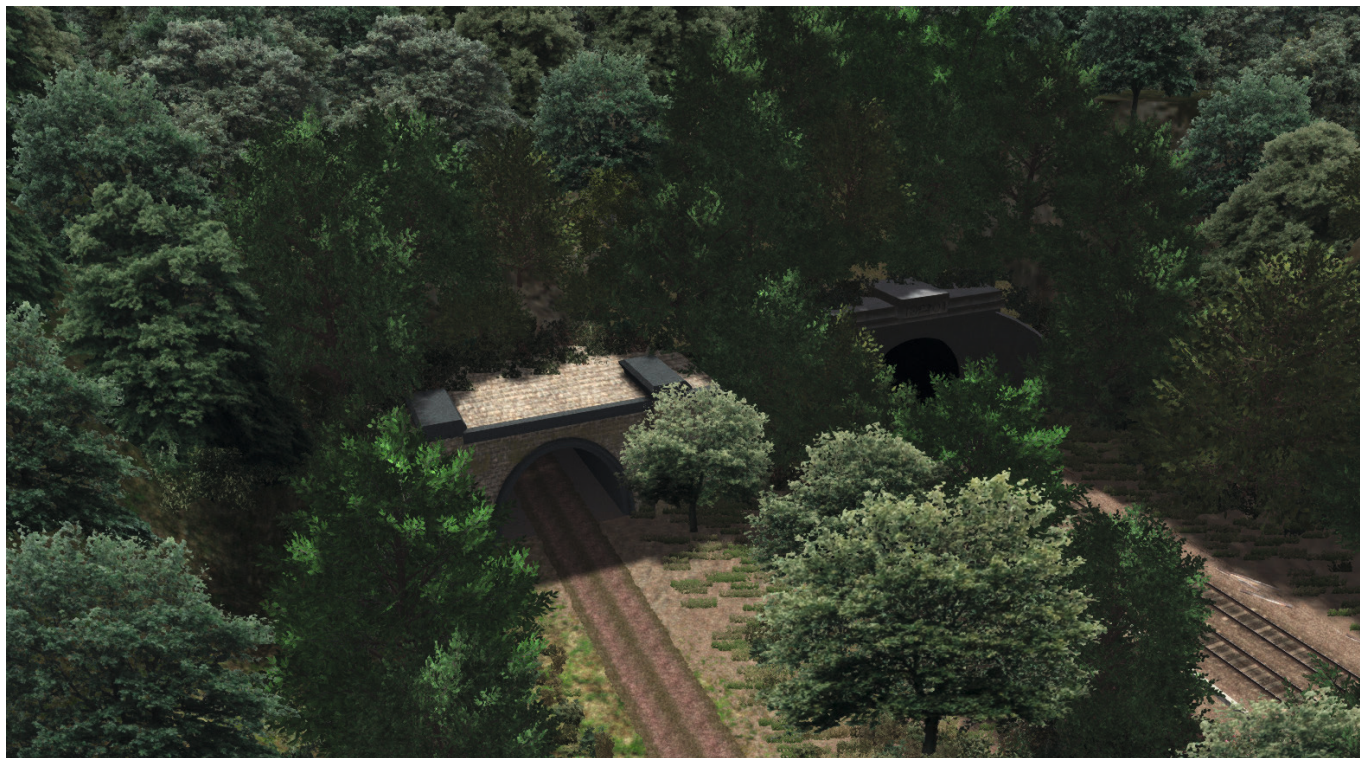


## Alfreton tunnels



There are two tunnels at this location: one in use for the railway and the other for access for rail works. Both ends have different portal designs. The second tunnel opened in 1901 and the now disused one closed in the late 1960s.





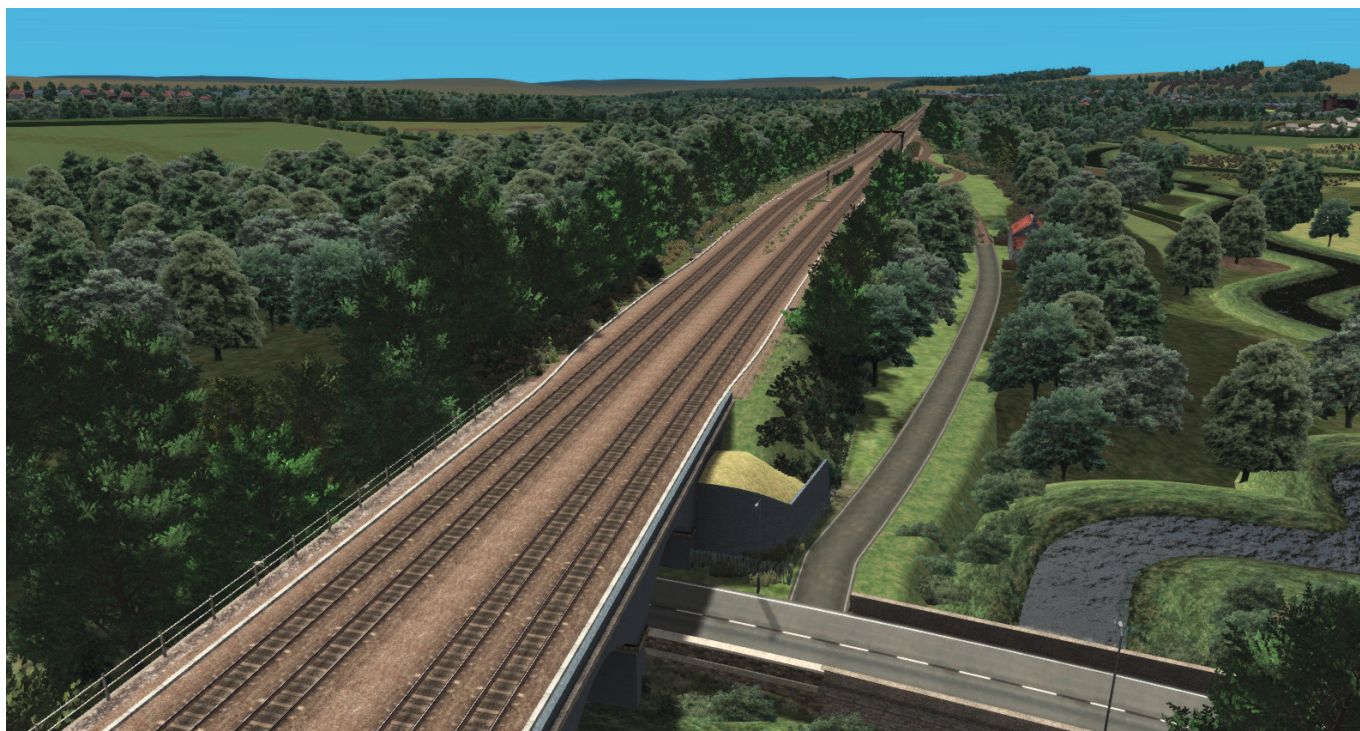
## Ironville Junction



This is where the line to Kirkby-in-Ashfield diverges from the Erewash Valley Line. This line is known as the 'Pinxton Line'.

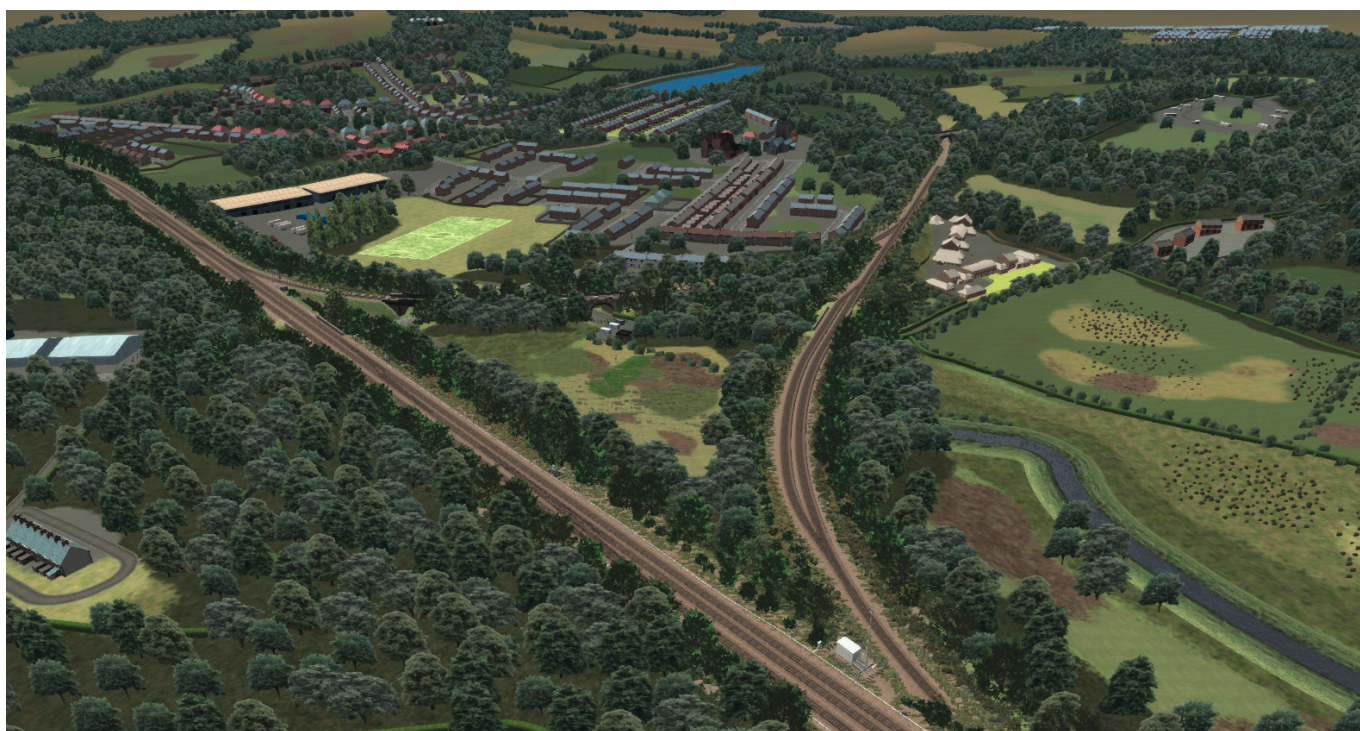


## Site of Pye Bridge station



The station opened as Pye Bridge for Alferton on 1 December 1851. It closed to both passenger and goods traffic on 2 January 1967.

## Codnor Park Junction



Today this junction provides access to and from the Midland Railway Centre. It was previously linked with Ambergate Junction.



## Site of Codnor Park and Ironville station



The station opened on 6 September 1847 and was closed to both passenger and goods traffic on 2 January 1967.

## Site of Shipley Gate station



Shipley Gate station opened on 1 July 1851 but was closed to passengers on 27 August 1948.

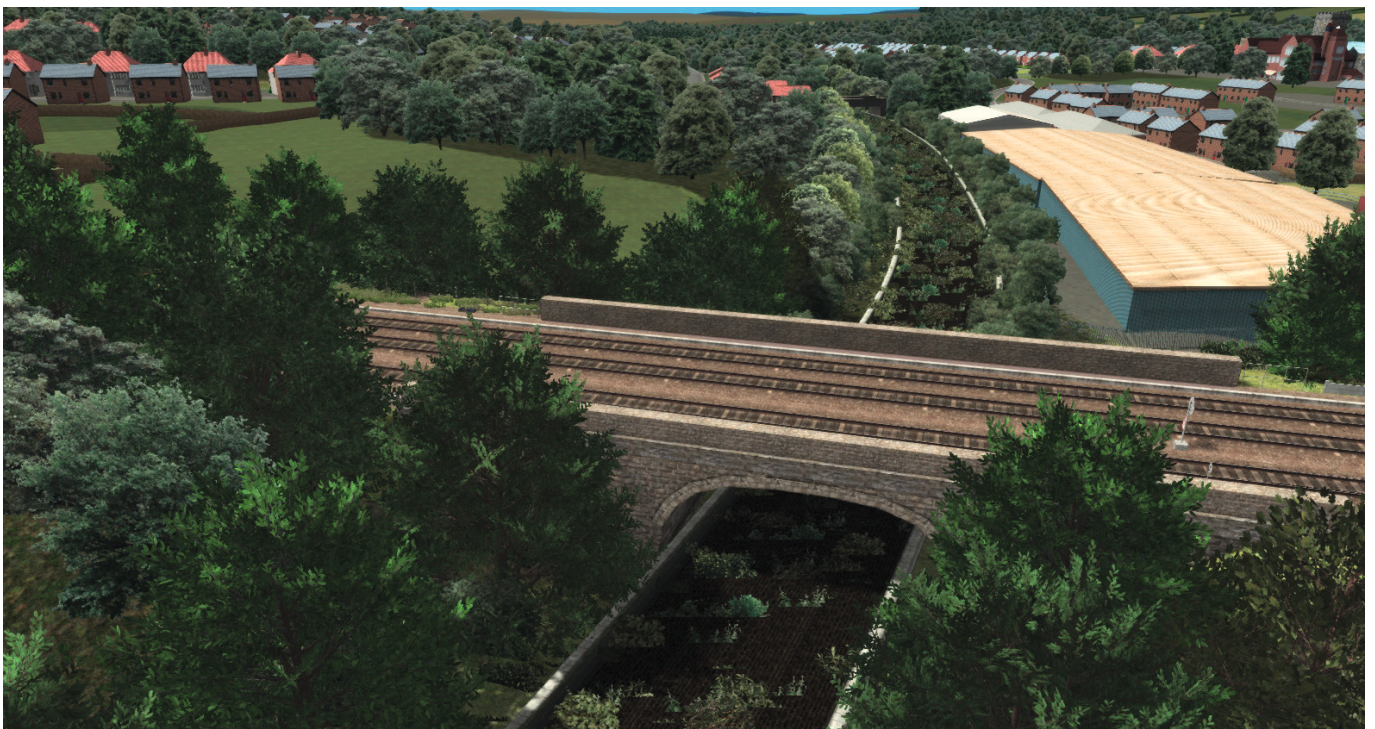


## Bennerley Viaduct



This viaduct was once part of the GNR Derbyshire and Staffordshire Extension. Today the viaduct is preserved and used as a public walkway and cycleway. This innovative wrought iron lattice structure was built in 1879.

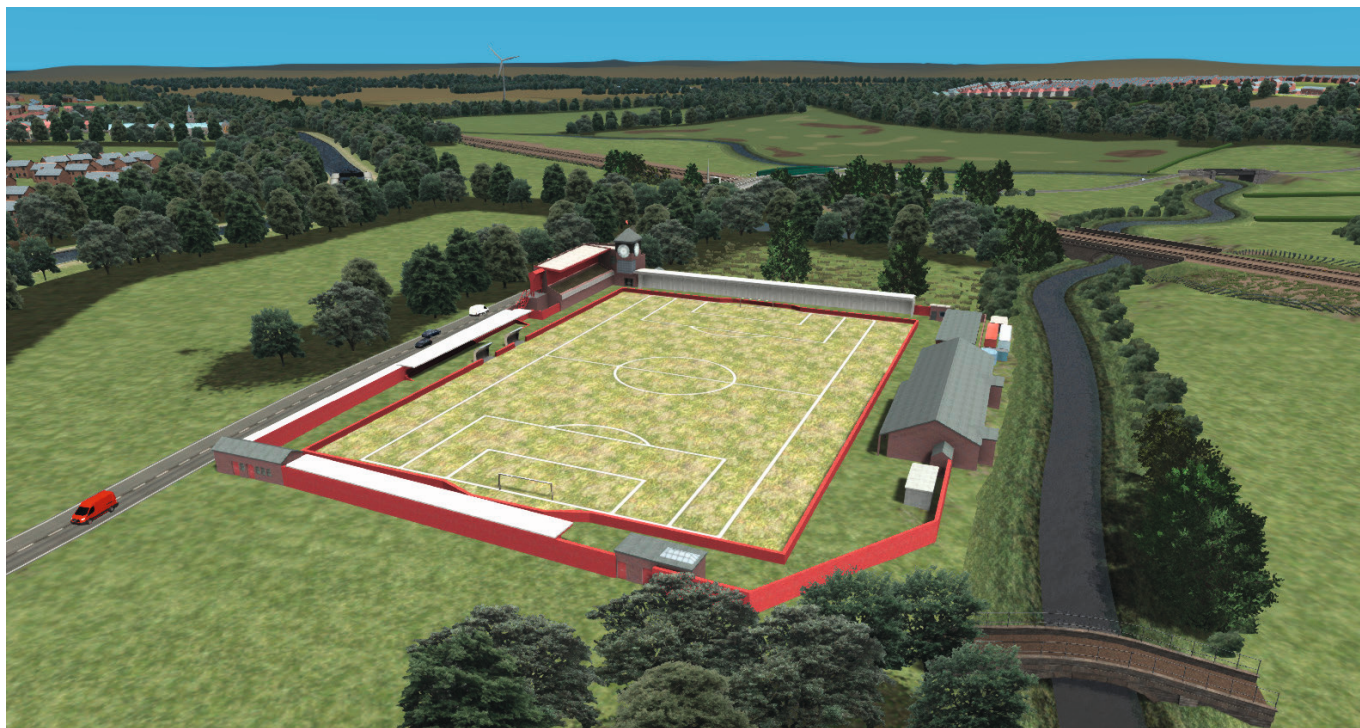
## Nottingham Canal



At this point the line crosses the now disused and overgrown Nottingham Canal.



## The New Manor Ground



This stadium is currently home to Ilkeston Town FC. It has a distinctive footballer-shaped weather vane on top of its large clock tower.



## Armstrong Mill



This historic mill overlooking the line is now home to retail units.

## Erewash Canal



The Erewash Canal runs beside the line here.

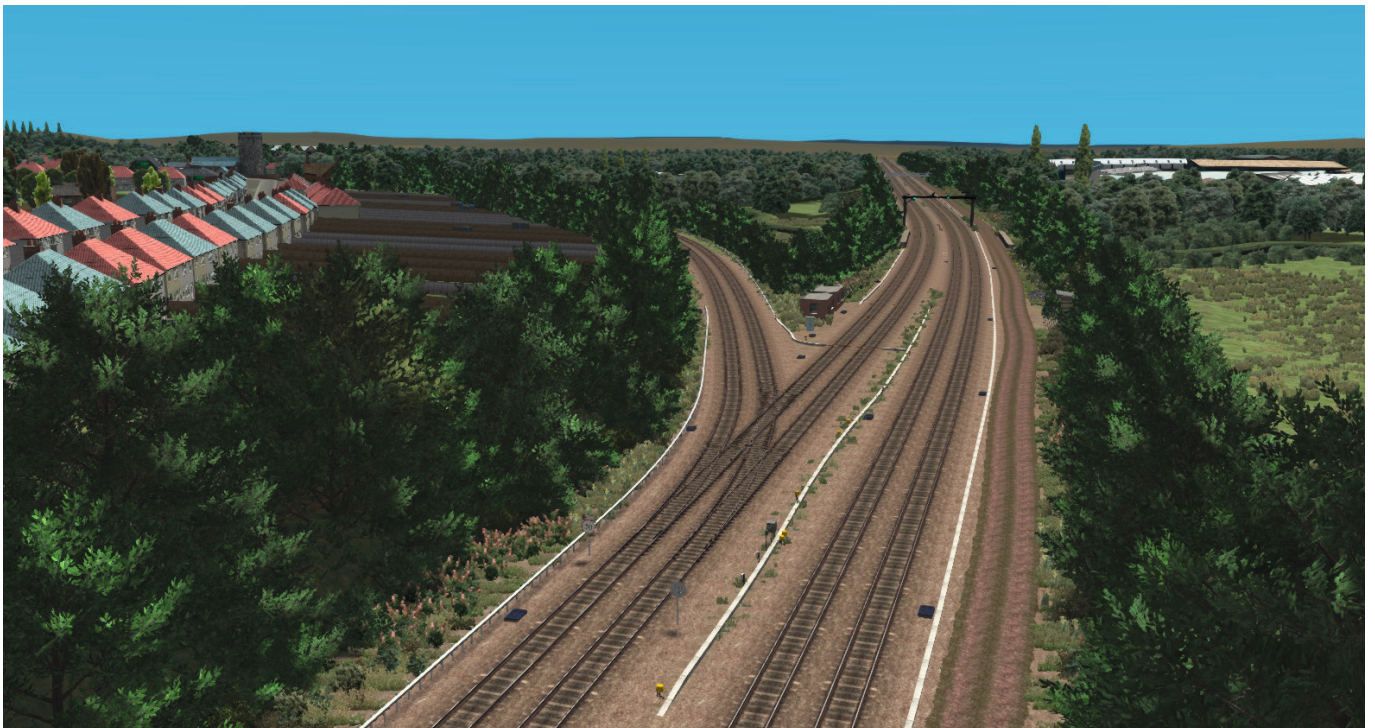


## Site of Trowell station



This station was opened in 1884 and closed in 1967.

## Trowell Junction



At this point you can take the line on the left to Nottingham, over the M1 motorway and via Radford Junction where it joins the line coming south from Mansfield. Otherwise the line continues south to Toton depot, where you will see the following features:



## M1 motorway bridge



At this point on the route the line passes under a bridge carrying the M1 motorway.

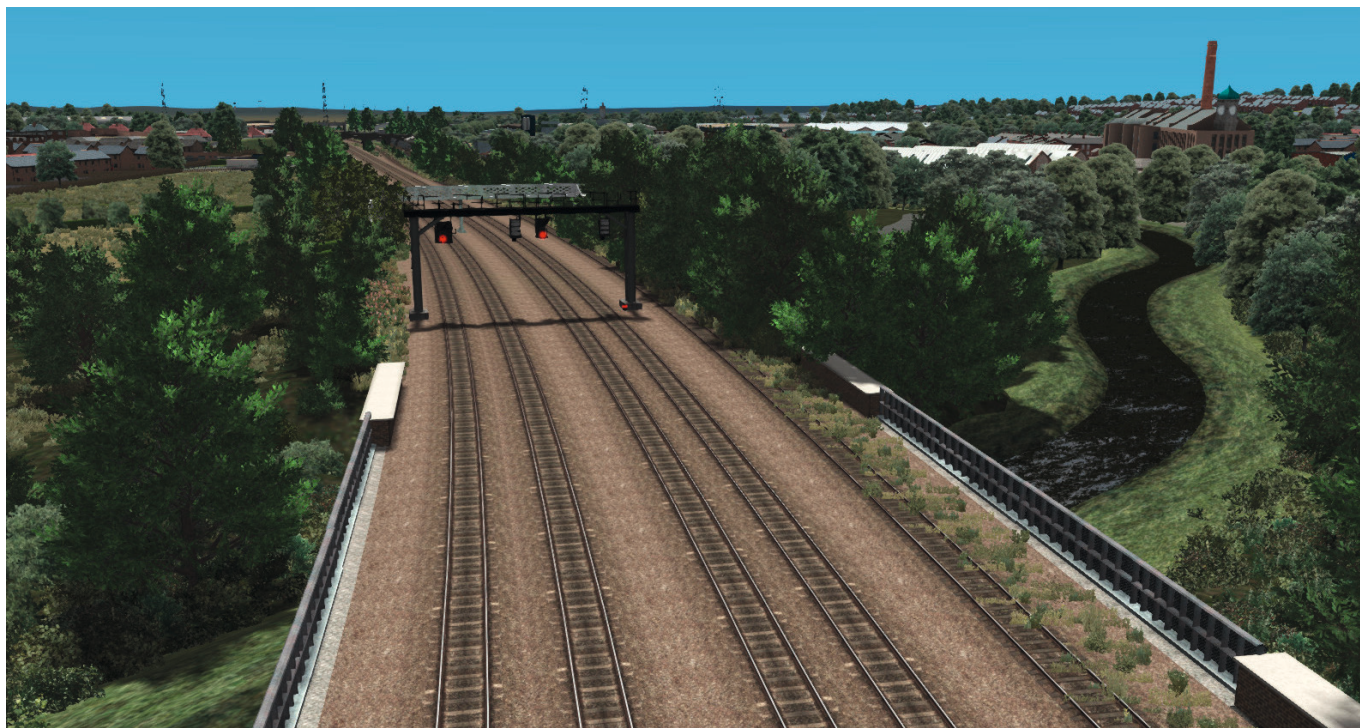
## Site of Stanton Gate station



This station was opened in 1851 and closed in 1967.



## River Erewash bridge



At this point the line goes over the River Erewash.

## Stanton Gate footbridge



The Stanton Gate footbridge goes over the line and the site of the long gone Stanton Gate New Sidings.



## Site of Stapleford and Sandiacre station



This station was opened in 1847 and closed in 1967.

The Erewash Valley route now connects to the Midland Main Line: Derby-Nottingham-Leicester route.



# SCENARIOS

## Choosing a scenario

When you first start Train Simulator, select the 'Drive' option in the Main Menu, then choose the Standard scenarios.

Use the scroll bar on the right side to scroll down to 'Just Trains – Midland Main Line'.

You can now choose your scenario and click on the 'Go' button.

16 Standard scenarios are included that require additional payware content.

12 Standard scenarios are included that only require default Train Simulator stock and the European Loco and Asset pack to run; these are prefixed with [Default].

# QUICK DRIVE

This route is equipped for use with the Quick Drive option in Train Simulator.

To access this option from the Main Menu, press the 'Drive' button and then the 'Quick Drive' tab at the top left.

## The Quick Drive menu

The top left area on the menu is where you select the train you wish to drive.

When you click on the menu directly to the right of the train picture, it shows the variations/consists available for the selected train in the right-side area of the menu. Click on the consist that you want to drive.

## Changing your train

If you want to drive a different train, click back on the top left train picture. The right side of the menu will change and will display all the trains you have installed in Train Simulator.

Use the 'Page' button located at the top middle of the pictures to scroll through them all.

All installed trains which have Quick Drive enabled are displayed. If the train does NOT have Quick Drive enabled, it will NOT be displayed in the Quick Drive menu.

## Selecting your route

When you have selected the train and consist you wish to drive, you then need to select the route.

In the middle left area are the route selection menus. Click on the middle far left route picture. This will change the right-side area of the menu to display the routes that you have installed in Train Simulator.

## Choosing departure and arrival stations

Click on the route 'map' image directly to the right of the route picture. This will then show the available departure and arrival points for the route. You can select them by clicking on the ones you want.

## Changing the time and weather

Controls for changing the time of day and weather conditions are on the lower left area. You can use these to adjust the time and weather settings as you wish.

## Driving

When you have made all your selections, press the 'Drive' button on the lower right side of the menu and Train Simulator will load your settings.



## IMPORTANT – Filters

In the Standard and Free Roam ‘Drive’ menus there are various locomotive and route filter options along the top of the right side. We strongly recommend that these are all set to ‘None’ unless you are experienced in using them.

**If you set a filter and forget to remove it, there is a strong possibility that not all the available locomotives and/or routes will be displayed in the menu.**

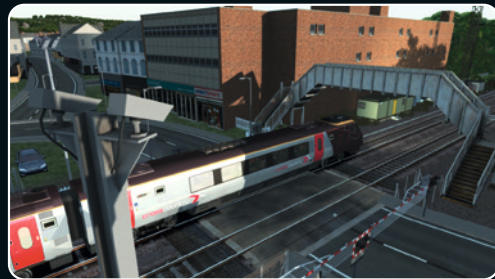
